NEWSLETTER TOP TIP

Rubber suspension cones should be replaced approx every 7 years due to wear. Your mini could be riding lower than intended or even on the bump stops, causing damage to other components. By replacing worn cones you dramatically improve the ride and handling of your mini. Always buy genuine cones as aftermarket ones have a tendency to collapse and fail.
